She holds graduate degrees in Biblical Counseling, Pastoral Counseling, Chaplaincy, and Christian Ministry Leadership, and is currently working on her Doctorate in Strategic Church Leadership as she tackles the impact of sexual abuse and exploitation issues in the church and other Christian communities.

Trish has published three books, *Raising Little Women of God: A Discipleship Journey for Mothers and Daughters* (Two-book curriculum) and *Connecting with Christ at Passover: A symbolic Seder Experience*. She has also co-authored books for Bethany House, Baker Publishing, and Guideposts.
